Pieter Maré and Gary Gilmore both taught at our residential Africa Missions Bible College—Rwanda. Both lecturers endeared themselves to our students.

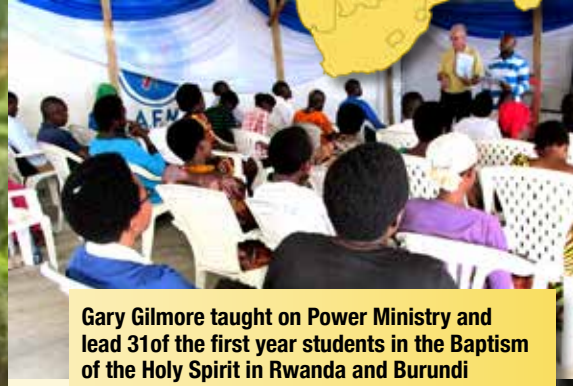


(Left to right) Four Pastors—Pieter Maré and Ron Kinnear of South Africa, Gary Gilmore of the U.S., and Desire of Burundi

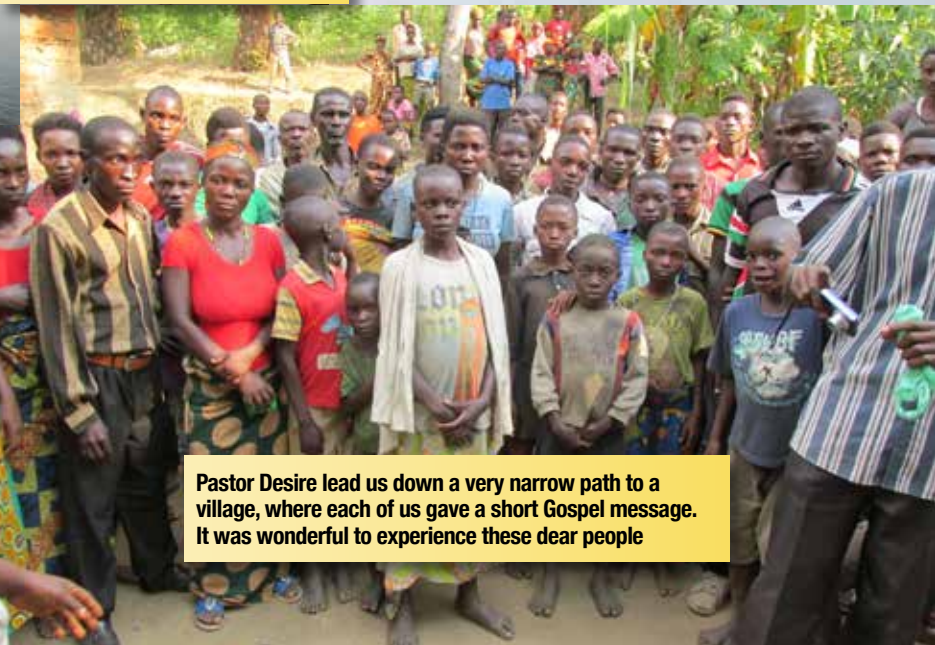


Teaching with an interpreter, Pieter Maré taught the third-year class, and they requested him for their graduation speaker.

Favour—What we are experiencing in our fields of operation is the Lord’s favour. His blessing is resting on our projects. We are making great strides in our leadership/pastoral training programmes. Our Evangelism programme has produced greater results than what we anticipated. Plans are coming together in the three new countries we have targeted—Ethiopia, Sudan, and Egypt. In addition we have been requested to assist in the restructuring of church groups in Burundi and Tanzania. My heart is overflowing with the Lord’s goodness. I can truly reiterate the words of an old hymn: “To God be the Glory, Great things He has done!”

Activities During 2017

- In February—Staff housing at the Bible College in Kigali, Rwanda has been roofed
- In February—Our partnership with APTEA (Africa Pentecostal Theological Education Association) has been strengthened. We are using a curriculum they have provided and we are getting wider recognition because of this association in African countries
- In March—New Satellite Campus was launched in Burundi
- In April—A church group in Tanzania was assisted in a restructuring process and leadership development will follow
- We are sponsoring some of the lecturers at the Bible College in Kigali who are pursuing further studies towards their Master’s degrees - July
- In June/July—Satellite Campus training was conducted in Burundi and Rwanda
- In June/July—Satellite Campus training was conducted in Uganda
- In June-August—Evangelism Celebrations were held in the DRC, Rwanda and Burundi in order to receive reports and updates on progress made towards our goal of 150,000 first-time decisions for Christ The actual figure now stands at 170,000 and still growing! We are still awaiting reports from Uganda, Tanzania, South Sudan and Ethiopia
- Rina’s King’s Daughters of Excellence had breakfasts and Rina was invited to speak at several conferences during August being *Woman’s Month* here in South Africa.


