On Wednesday, the 5th of February 2020, Ps "Thabo" van Wyk departed for Kampala, Uganda. The purpose of the journey was to lead a 2-week Empowerment Mission to Uganda. Once in Capital City, 'Thabo' was joined by the three National Officials of the AFM in Uganda: Bishop Emmanuel Kambonge (President) Pas-

This powerful team travelled to three regional centres within Uganda to present Empowerment Seminars for pastors and leaders of the AFM. Kampala, Mubende, and Mbarara were chosen as the central points to gather pastors.

training and empowerment, mainly presented by Pastor 'Thabo' van Wyk, whose Portfolio within Africa Missions is that of Church Development. Pastors received teaching and training on the following topics:

- Historical overview of the AFM
- My role as a pastor within the AFM
- Biblical Stewardship
- Accountability—The life of Paul
- Visionary Leadership—The life of Nehemiah
- Teamwork—TEAM: Together Everyone Achieves More
- Basic Administration Principles— Concerning Secretaries
- Basic Financial Principles— Concering Treasurers

Although we initially intended to host five delegates per region, bringing the total attendance per venue to between 15 and 20, we were met with overwhelming enthusiasm. Each venue had to cope with between 10 and 15 additional attendees. The main reason being that the leaders were so eager to be trained. As we concluded our training, we calculated that instead of the initial 50 pastors we planned to cater for, a total of 95 pastors & leaders were trained!

This mission was the first in a series of initiatives that will be embarked upon by **Africa Missions** to strengthen the organizational structures of the Church in Uganda and empower leaders on a grassroot level.

As we concluded the mission, we also

- 2. Pastor 'Thabo' in Mubende, Uganda, with the Regional Pastors
- Uganda Church members come together to learn from God's Word and Worship, even without proper facilities.
- 4. The children and young people gather to learn God's Word.









facilitated meetings with the organisers of the APMC Conference and Harvesters International respectively. Africa Missions will be involved in the Africa Pentecostal Missions Consultation that will take place from 19-22 May 2020 in Kampala. Running up to May, 2020, several AFM pastors, including the National Executive, will receive training in Church Planting Strategies. This training will be presented by Harvesters International.
