- Robert and Susan are completely committed to their task of raising up an army for the lord. They are performing miracles with the limited resources available. They are missionaries from Kenya and have been well received by the broader church leadership in Rwanda.
- They have also enlisted the services of **Pastor Aaron** from Uganda who completed his studies at the Njoro Bible College in Kenya as a lecturer.

## Ron Traveled to EAST AFRICA

In March **Ron Kinnear** visited Rwanda and Uganda. **Pastor Robert Owade** and **Pastor Evariste Sibomana** (from Burundi) formed part of the team. They had a very productive and fruitful visit to Rwanda and Uganda.

### In RWANDA:

- We met the new students of the Kigali Bible College and had a wonderful time of impartation with them.
- E.E. 3 Training proposals were also discussed with the leadership.
- Assisted by **Robert Owade** **Ron** we met with the authorities to discuss the approval on the building plans for the new Bible College campus situated in Bugesera.
- Land was also purchased from the Anglican Church. We now have direct access onto our property.

### In UGANDA:

- The effects of the **SOMETHING EXTRA** Project are felt and seen all over country.
- NATIONAL CONFERENCE AND WORKER'S COUNCIL: The big turnout at the National AFM Conference in Mbarara was attributed to the E.E.3 Clinics that Africa Missions presented in conjunction with Evangelism Explosion in Uganda. New Office Bearers were elected during the Worker's Council. Delegates from 84 local churches were registered. Not included in this figure are 15 NEW CHURCHES THAT WERE PLANTED LAST YEAR.
- The team was able to visit several churches. To our amazement we saw the effects of EE3 training even in the remotest villages. A great harvest is coming in!
- Two donations from the **Akin's Trust** were made to local churches: In BANDA for the roofing timber of their new church and MBARARA to complete the roofing on their new church.

#### TEAM WORK BIBLE COLLEGE

We have 47 active students this year. Nine of these students should be graduating with B. Th. Degrees in November this year. For the first time ever, we have three students in the Masters Program.

#### HAAKDOORNBOOM CAMPUS

**Bertus** and **Marouda De Jager** have taken on the responsibility to complete the last building that is under construction on the campus. This is truly an undertaking from the Lord for which we are very grateful.

#### KIGALI BIBLE COLLEGE

We have 40 students enrolled in a three year ministerial course. All are resident on campus. These students come from Rwanda, Burundi, Uganda and Tanzania. This year history will be made. In November we will have our first GRADUATION!

#### KIGALI—BUGESERA CAMPUS

Additional land was purchased in March to give us a pan-handle access road onto our land. Plans were submitted to the authorities and we are anxiously awaiting approval. As soon as the plans are approved we will immediately commence with the construction of the first dormitory building.
