We have been acquainted with Reinhardt and his team for over 30 years. Ron was launched into missions at the same time that Reinhardt went to Lesotho as a German missionary. Ron also served as crusade chairman for Reinhardt's crusades in Cape Town and Zimbabwe.

Rina is best of friends with Thea, Reinhardt's South African Director. They work together on an annual basis bringing high profile women in ministry together for a time of refreshing and prayer.

Reinhardt introduced his successor Daniel Kolenda and despite jetlag brought a powerful message at the impartation breakfast. Daniel spoke at a church in the evening and it was our joy to continue our fellowship with the team.

Transporting Ten Tents

Ten large tents with a seating capacity of 300 were donated to churches in the Democratic Republic of the Congo and Rwanda.

Previous Tent Troubles

Our major challenge was to get the tents to these countries. A truck loaded with tents had simply disappeared in Tanzania! Other tents were held up at borders and were never allowed to be taken into the respective countries by customs officials. Due to these nightmare experiences Judea Harvest was willing to donate the tents BUT to get the tents to the target countries became our challenge. We had just about exhausted all hope of transporting the tents when the miracle happened!

A Divine Connection

Flying from Kigali, Rwanda, we met a couple from South Africa who were involved in installing irrigation systems on farms in Rwanda on contract with the Government. They offered to take the tents as far as Rwanda in containers they planned to send. Benno and Amanda Robinson were true to their word. Five tents have already reached Rwanda and another five tents will soon be loaded. All the freight charges were borne by them.

We took the liberty and sent new diesel-powered generators for the tents, paint for the Bible college and steel shelving, as well.



We express our heartfelt gratitude to this precious couple and pray that the Lord will prosper them beyond measure in all their endeavours in Rwanda.

40,000 people saved in 4 years!



We are thrilled to announce that 40,000 people have given their lives to Jesus through this ministry over the last 4 years! Praise the Lord! At first we stretched our faith to believe for 20,000 souls for the Lord in 3 years (2007-2010), which the Lord far exceeded with a harvest of 26,000 precious souls for His Kingdom!

Having reached and exceeded our first goal, we began to set more goals:

By 2013 we are trusting the Lord to win 50,000 souls (this includes the 40,000 reached so far)

By 2018 we are trusting the Lord to win 100,000 souls

By 2021 we are trusting the Lord to win 500,000 souls.

David Khoza was launched into ministry by directing our **Jesus Film Project**. He later combined this with Gospel crusades. Thousands of people were saved.

He then planted a church which has become a mother-church with several church plantings. Today he is highly regarded as an Apostle although he has never referred to himself as such. David still has a very close relationship with us.

In October, David dedicated a new church building to the Lord in Marikana in South Africa. Ron was invited to officially open the church. From a house church to meeting in a tent this new congregation built their new church building fully funded by themselves.

Calvin Hall from South Carolina was visiting with us at the time. He brought a powerful message at the inauguration of the new facility.

TLABANG JOHANNES SKOSANA is another son. He is affectionately known as "TJ," and graduated from the **Central Bible College** that Ron directed for twelve years. He entered the ministry and became a successful pastor and a lecturer at an accredited Bible College. He also became involved in several community projects and also spoke out against injustices during the Apartheid years in South Africa. He relentlessly pursued further study and finally, after many years of perseverance, received his Doctorate in Theology from the University of South Africa which is a fully accredited University.

TJ invited several people to celebrate this achievement with him. There were several dignitaries and government leaders present. Ron was asked to open the event with a scripture reading and prayer. TJ gave Ron, amongst others, a fruit tree to plant in his garden signifying the fruit on his labours.
