## ABUSED WOMEN IN GOMA

Militia on all fronts in the Eastern part of the DRC abuse women as a means of controlling and manipulating people. Those who did not support their “cause” would be warned to change their attitude or suffer the consequences. The “consequence” meant that all the females in a house hold, irrespective of age, would be gang-raped. All the males in the household would be forced to watch. This has led to unwanted pregnancies, broken marriages, and neglected children to mention but a few of the results of this abuse.


A Christian organization in Goma, DRC, has been of great help to many of these abused women. Many have been taught different types of skills that would enable them to generate income to provide for themselves and their children born under these circumstances. In the process, inner healing also took place as they turned to the Lord who forgives, comforts, and makes everything new.

Rina has undertaken to help this organization with sewing machines. At a cost of \$300, a deeply traumatized and abused women can regain her dignity and self worth.
