1. Our Older Land Rover needs a new engine.

It is desparetly needed for our AM team in Rwanda and for traveling to surrounding countries. This will help the AM Bible College and AM Teams that visit.We need it to save time and money for transportation.

Cost—R15,000




3. Evangelism

This is when we teach 60-80 local pastors per clinic in personal evangelism in Central-East Africa— Burundi, Rwanda, Tanzania, Uganda, DRC, South Sudan, and Ethiopia. These clinics empower the local church to grow itself, answer Jesus' call to evangelize, and help us to reach our target of 150,000 new Christians in 9 years!

Cost—R40,000 per clinic

These evangelism training clinics are expensive. They cost more than opening a Bible College. But we see their amazing effectiveness.

4. Celebrations! — Celebrations are the backbone of our evangelism program, when we return months later to those we previously trained in evangelism. This gathering is needed for every country in Central-East Africa and is a great encouragement for the 60-80 pastors who attend each celebration to evangelize so they can report. If we don't have celebrations, then we don't get updates. It is prestigious for the other pastors and encourages soul winning so they can report a good number of people they have lead to the Lord.




Land Rover needs repairs.

2. Our Newer

It is in Burundi and when fixed it will greatly help the AM Teams in Burundi, Uganda, Tanzania because public transportation is very high and takes much time.

Cost—R12,000



5. Sewing Machines

To help abused women in Goma, DRC the *Association of Abused Women* have asked for 3 sewing machines so

they can make a living. Many of these women were raped by the warring militants who made their husbands watch. Then their husbands do not want anything to do with them. Robert & Susan Owade are the wonderful principals of our Bible College in Rwanda.



6. Principal's House

We must finish the house for the principals of our Africa Missions Bible College in Rwanda. It will accomodate the principal and family,



as well as AM Teams that visit. The walls are up and ready for the roof.

Cost—R350,000 to complete

R70,000 urgently need

to complete roof!

7. Roofs of Churches in Refugee Camps



Yes, they have Churches inside the Refugee Camps in Rwanda. They have escaped from the DRC and built

their own churches with mud bricks. If those bricks could be protected, that church would stand for 20+ years. There are 3 churches that need a roof.

Cost—R18,000 per roof

The needs are great; but God is greater and we are trusting in Him to fulfill these pressing needs and to move in the hearts of His people to assist us. Will you help us? We need you. We appreciate you, your prayers and your generous financial support.
